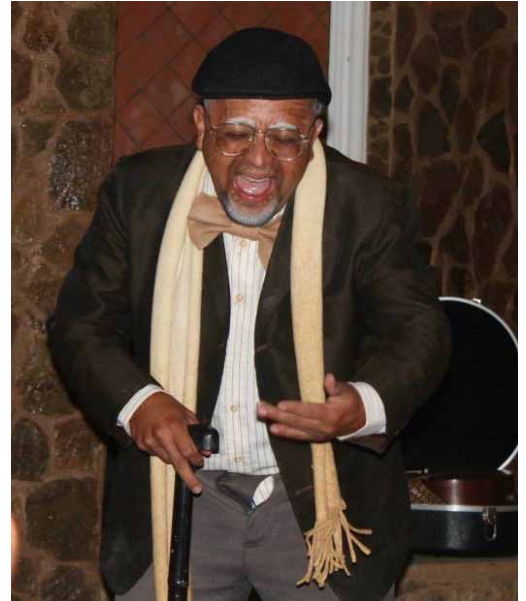


The Micah Project

D-House team from Houston



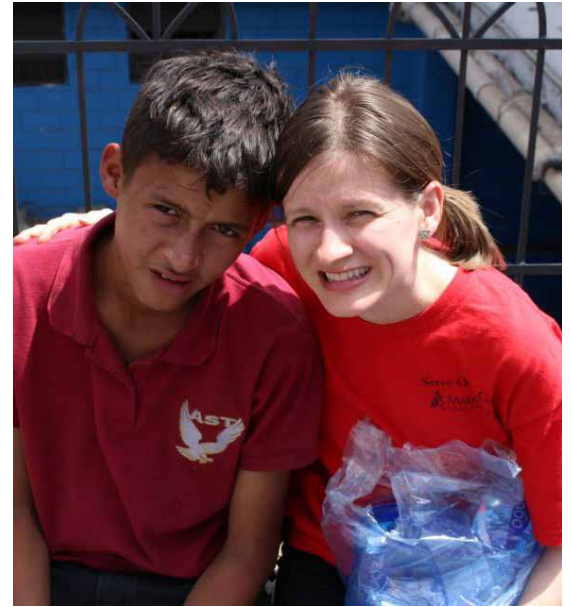
The D-house team from First Presbyterian Church in Houston helped us build another section of our perimeter wall. It is getting so close to being finished!

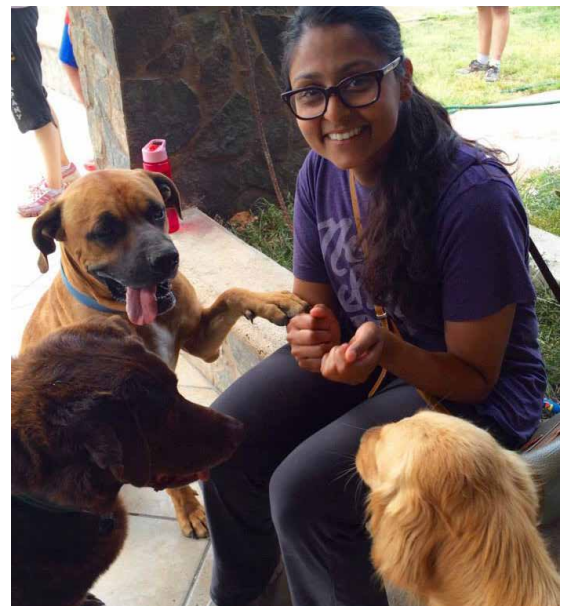
